Last Week

Sandhills Area Land Trust



Candace Williams, Associate Director for the Sandhills Area Land Trust, was our guest speaker last week. She leads the land protection efforts of the Cumberland County office in

Fayetteville. She received the 2006 Governor's Conservation Achievement Award as the NC Land Conservationist of the Year - the State's highest natural resource honor. In 2008, she was recognized by the National Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution with The Woman in American History Award for outstanding service and contributions made in the field of conservation on behalf of the people of North Carolina.

Candace presented an outstanding video describing the Sandhills Area Land Trust (SALT). Founded in 1991, SALT is a community-based, non-profit organization that serves Moore, Richmond, Scotland, Hoke, Cumberland and Harnett counties in southeastern North Carolina. SALT works with private landowners to negotiate voluntary conservation easements on private property. Following the video, she explained how SALT has protected more than 8,200 acres of working farms, water supplies, endangered ecosystems and urban open space in our six county service region. She described these successful efforts: Conservation-Based Affordable Housing, Drowning Creek Water Supply Watershed, Hobby Field, Jessup's Mill Pond and River Oaks Preserve.
